Cabinet Meeting and Rally

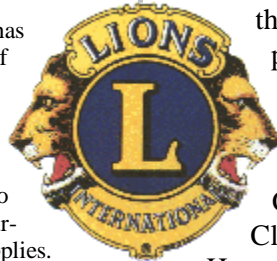

LCIF Responds to the Turkish Earthquake Disaster

The Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) has awarded, to date, \$140,000 in grants for the victims of the Turkish earthquake disaster. Past International Director Nesim Levi of Turkey is overseeing the relief efforts of the Lions in that country. On the day of the earthquake, LCIF approved the disbursement of \$40,000 in emergency grants to the Turkish Lions to provide for urgent needs of the victims, such as the purchase of food, bedding, clothing and basic medical supplies. These funds were provided in the form of four \$10,000 grants given to the four affected Lions districts. Lions Clubs International President Jim Ervin and LCIF Chairman Kajit Habanananda approved an additional LCIF Major Catastrophe grant of \$100,000. These funds will be used over an extended period of time in response to longer-term needs.

LCIF has also established a fund to receive donations earmarked for victims of the Turkish earthquake. Donations can be sent by check made payable to LCIF, with the words "Turkish earthquake" written in the memo field. (Note: These restricted donations do not qualify for Melvin Jones Fellow recognition but the donation will appear on the club's and district's permanent giving records.) Restricted donations will be sent to Lions in the region for various immediate and long-term relief efforts, depending on the most pressing needs identified in the coming weeks.
