It turns out that the Lighthouse had paid for an eye surgery for him many years ago, and that a Lions Club had purchased glasses for both he and his brother while he was growing up. Without the surgery we paid for, he would have lost his sight. He doesn't make a lot of money, but he always gives to Lions for White Cane.

I was dropping a dollar into the Salvation Army kettle right before the holidays, and ended up getting into a conversation with the woman who was collecting the money. It turns out that she had received glasses from a Lions Club when she was growing up. She doesn't have the time to join a Lions Club, but she does volunteer with worthy organizations when she can. She too makes a point of giving to Lions.

Two chance encounters. Two people whose lives where changed by the generosity of the Georgia Lions. I think every Lion has at least one story like this. Every day we are changing lives, and everyday people are telling others about what we have done. Here at the Lighthouse, we are in the business of making a difference in peoples lives, and we are thankful that you are so supportive of our efforts. Together, we help write many happy endings.

You will find several things included with this packet, including the White Cane booklet. Last year, a number of you indicated that it would be helpful if we mailed the packets out in January. Feel free to copy and distribute to your White Cane Committee. We will also have additional copies at the Lighthouse meeting in February. White Cane contributions fund sight services, and are absolutely essential if we are to continue our work. We currently have a temporary cap on services due to a lack of funds, so every dollar you raise is very much needed!

This meeting is a great opportunity to hear about the lives we have been impacting on a daily basis, and for you to learn more about what we are accomplishing together. Please note that the location for the meeting is Macon State college and that we have rooms blocked at the Holiday Inn Macon West. I encourage you to come to the meeting and to bring a member of your Club with you. This is a great opportunity for newer Lions to learn about what we do.

Finally, enclosed are the reports for the month of December. Please feel free to make copies of them and share with your Club members and friends. One Lighthouse Associate Director that I know makes copies of the reports and distributes them to her club members. This is an easy way to let your club know what is going on at the Lighthouse, and what they are helping to make happen. It is important that Lions all over Georgia know what we are doing, and about the lives we are impacting.

Last, but certainly not least, I'd like to encourage you to think about making a "Lions New Year's Resolution" this year. Tell at least one person a month (now THAT'S not too hard!!) about a person whose life has been changed by the Lions or by the Lighthouse. You will be doing an important service by letting people know what we do, you will help recruit new Lions, and you will be getting the Lighthouse story out to our larger Lions family. We need to do a better job of sharing our story, and you can make a big difference by helping us in this way.
